ELECTROLYTE REPLACEMENT

What is Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement?

Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement is a palatable flavored aqueous solution of electrolytes and nutrients formulated:

- to replenish fluids, minerals and glucose at optimal absorption rates which are depleted through stress, physical exertion or illness.
- to prevent or reduce the severity of heat stress disorders
- to provide a supplemental source of energy and quench thirst.

What are Electrolytes?

Technically, they are minerals (magnesium, potassium, sodium and calcium). Salivary loss (evaporating or drooling) is probably the most significant source of systemic electrolyte loss in animals during physical exertion or heat stress situations. Under ideal conditions electrolytes flow through muscle cells to keep them functioning normally. Excessive salivary loss depletes cells of fluids and weakens the muscle tissue. Within seconds of drinking Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement, electrolytes are restored within the cell. And in the process, energy (performance) is restored.

How is Taste Important?

Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement's good tasting natural flavor assures acceptance. Initial test results indicate a preference by animals for the full bodied flavor and aroma of Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement solution over water or other electrolyte solutions. Special flavors have been developed for the various species to insure maximum intake.

How Do I Use Epi-Pet Electrolyte Replacement?

Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement is easy to mix. Just add to 20oz. of water and dissolve. You can refrigerate unused portions for later use. Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement can be served cold/hot or as a broth over dry food. And Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement is safe for human consumption!

When Do I Use Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement?

There is a growing awareness that many animals are lost unnecessarily every year due to heat stress, but no pet owner should overlook the fact that other problems causing DEHYDRATION necessitate REHYDRATION.

Post-surgery recovery, gastro-intestinal upset (i.e. diarrhea, vomiting), fever, emotional stress (strenuous exercise, air travel, etc) are occurrences in small animals that call for fluid and electrolyte therapy. Administration of rehydration therapy orally is recommended in mild to moderate dehydration.

Preventative rehydration can sometimes eliminate or reduce stress symptoms in small animals. Mixing Epi-Pet's Electrolyte Replacement with the animal's drinking water and allowing the animal to ingest the product prior to strenuous exercise, whelping, travel or surgery is beneficial.
